**DECISION AND ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT**

---

Plaintiff filed a Motion for Summary Judgment on Count 1 of the amended complaint, granting rescission of Joseph B. Saluri's assignment of BlueAllele Units to Joseph and Lori Saluri Ventures, LLC and the assignment of Joseph and Lori Saluri Ventures, LLC units to the Saluri 2021 Trust and on Count 2 of the Amended Complaint dissolving Joseph and Lori Saluri Ventures, LLC and awarding Joseph Saluri attorney fees and costs. Defendant Lori L. Saluri filed a brief agreeing that summary judgment on rescission should be granted and taking no position on summary judgment on dissolution or the award of attorney fees. Defendant Joseph and Lori Saluri Ventures, LLC took no position on the motion.

The parties have effectively stipulated to summary judgment. The court declines to enter findings of fact or conclusions of law. It is unnecessary because of the stipulation to the relief sought, and because the practice of making findings of fact on summary judgment motions is discouraged. *Bank of New Glarus v. Swartwood*, 2006 WI App 224, ¶11 n.5, 297 Wis. 2d 458, 725 N.W.2d 944

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED,

1. Joseph B. Saluri's assignment of BlueAllele Units to Joseph and Lori Saluri Ventures, LLC and the assignment of Joseph and Lori Saluri Ventures, LLC units to the Saluri 2021 Trust are **RESCINDED**.

2. Joseph and Lori Saluri Ventures, LLC is DISSOLVED pursuant to §183.0902(1).
3. Plaintiff is awarded statutory attorney fees and costs and shall submit his application under §814.04 within 14 days of entry of this order. Any objection to the application shall be made within 10 days of the filing of the application.
4. If no objection to the application for fees and costs, plaintiff shall file a proposed judgment according to this order after expiration of the objection period. If an objection is filed the court will review the objection and determine whether it requires a response or hearing.
